SIX WORDS -

'TO THIS CAUSE DID I COME'

John 18:37

"Pilate therefore said unto Him, Art you a king then? Jesus answered, 'You say that I am a king. To this cause did I come, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Everyone that is of the truth heareth my voice'".

GOD SENT THE REDEEMER

There is no condemnation in Christ.

Romans 8:1-2

"1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus made me free from the law of sin and of death."

Jesus came for man.

Genesis 1:31

"...man was created on the sixth-day."

Genesis 6:13

"God said. 'I have determined to make an end of all flesh. The earth is full with violence; behold, I will destroy them with the earth.'"

Revelation 13:18

"The number of a man is 666."

In both Hebrew and Arabic, each letter of the alphabet has a number assigned to it. For example, the letter W = 6. So, when we type www and log on to an internet website, we are entering the "Global Web" which control all business transactions, banking and peoples' daily lifestyle. But we are simultaneously typing in the biblical numbers 666. Thus, www = World Wide Web = Man. The Bible was written for man: 66 books in all, 39 in the Old Testament, 27 in the New Testament. Man = 66.

- 6: The sixth book in the Old Testament is Joshua first book named after Man.
- 6: The 6 book in the New Testament is Romans: Romans 6:6 the 6 word is Man.
- 6: Jesus was 33 years old went he went to Calvary cross $3+3=6$
- 6: Jesus was on the cross and crucified from 9 A.M till 3 P.M 6 hours He died. For Man)
- 6: Friday is the sixth day of the week which has six letters. (Man)
