The Mystery Of Cultivating Spiritual Eyes and Ears

Cultivating a daily lifestyle of giving the Word and Spirit first place in your life, will develop your spiritual eyes and ears to see and hear spiritual things with Love.

Born again Spirit filled believers who confess that Jesus is the Son of God and who continually are filled with the Spirit of the Lord, have the God given ability to accurately hear and see into the spirit realm. The Spirit of Truth, the Holy Spirit has come and is always leading and guiding us, but we have to be willing to hear and to see with spiritual discernment.

John 16:13 “but when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come”.

Romans 8:14 “for all who are being led by the spirit of God, these are the Sons of God”.

In Matthew 13:16 Jesus said unto his disciples, “but blessed are your eyes, because they see, and your ears, because they hear”.

In the preceding verse 11 Jesus told his disciples “to you it has been granted to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven”. Our spiritual eyes are blessed to see and our spiritual ears are blessed to hear. Unto us it is given the spiritual ability to accurately discern, hear, and see spiritual things with clarity; to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God.

1 John 2:20 “but you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things” (NKJV).

Our born-again Spirits have the God-given ability to see and hear spiritual things and principles with clarity and accuracy.

This God-given ability to see and hear spiritual things with clarity depends on our willingness to humble ourselves before God and to submit to his Spirit, the Word, and his ways. We must cultivate a lifestyle of submission to the Spirit of the Lord and his Word.

In Acts 6:2-4, the apostles said it was not good to neglect the Word, that they must devote themselves to prayer and ministry of the Word, and that men filled with the Spirit were to be appointed to serve the ministry of helps.

The impact of these decisions to place the Word and Spirit first, led to signs, wonders, miracles, the Word increasing, and exponential multiplication on the numbers of believers.

The book of Acts records many instances on the impact of submission to the leading and guiding of the Spirit of the Lord. According to Acts 17:6, these Spirit and Word led men and women turned the world upside down.

How do we develop and fine tune our spiritual eyes and ears? It is very simple. In John 6:63 Jesus said that his words were spirit and life.

John 1:1 “in the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God”.

It all begins with the Word of God which he has exalted above his name, which endures forever, which will never pass away, and feeds very life of God into our spirits. As we exalt the Word of God, giving it first place in our lives by continually hearing it, seeing it, reading it, meditating upon it, praying it, and doing it, our real selves, the spirit man or woman in us, will begin to grow and build itself up gaining ascendancy over the voices of our soul and flesh.

Spiritual things can only be spiritually discerned through the spirit and not the soul or the flesh.

It is written in **1 Corinthians 2:14** “but the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned” (KJV).

There is much more which can be written on how the human spirit, soul, and flesh operates; and how to rise up and continually let the spirit of the Lord in union with your spirit cause our spirits to submit to the leading of the Holy Spirit.

A second step to take in fine tuning our spiritual eyes and ears is building up ourselves praying in the Spirit.

Jude 20 “but you beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit”.

This is a spiritual mystery that taps into the very power and life of God which infuses our spirit man or woman with God’s life. Helping us to be strengthen with the very might of God to empower our spirits to rightly discern the soul and spirit, and to gain mastery over our natural tendency to allow our physical senses, the flesh, to rule over our Spirits.

There are a number of other steps which are crucial in developing spiritual eyes and ears to see and hear.

In Conclusion:

It is imperative to understand that developing spiritual eyes and ears is also vary dependent on how much time we give to hear, meditate, and spiritually study these spiritual principles.

Mark 4:24-28 “and He said to them, be careful what you are hearing. The measure [of thought and study] you give [to the truth you hear] will be the measure [of virtue and knowledge] that comes back to you—and more [besides] will be given to you who hear. For to him who has will more be given; and from him who has nothing,

even what he has will be taken away [by force], and He said, the kingdom of God is like a man who scatters seed upon the ground, and then continues sleeping and rising night and day while the seed sprouts and grows and increases—he knows not how. The earth produces [acting] by itself—first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in the ear” (AMPC).

If your desire is to see True manifestation of the miracle working power of God through the Holy Spirit. Seek the Word day and night. Live Matthew 6:33 Seek you first the Kingdom of God and it's righteousness Then All things should be added unto you.
